Calendar Art and Local and Loved Cookbooks!!

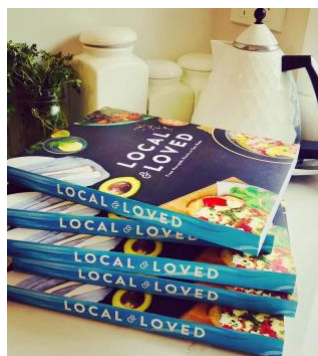
All calendar art orders must be in and paid for by Monday 1st November. Payment can be made via Kindo or internet banking. Orders cannot be accepted without payment.


